

Channel 4's responsibilities in connection with Premium Rate Telephony Services

Changes to the Channel's Licence took effect on 1 August 2008. These changes required the Channel to appoint an independent party to review and report on the Channel's procedures in relation to the provision of Premium Rate Telephony Services. PriceWaterhouseCoopers were appointed to be the independent party to review the Channel's procedures. Reviews were conducted of all processes and procedures in relation to Big Brother 9, Orange Unsigned Act and Celebrity Big Brother. The directors are satisfied that the Channel has in place suitable procedures to fulfil the requirements of paragraph 3b of its Licence.
