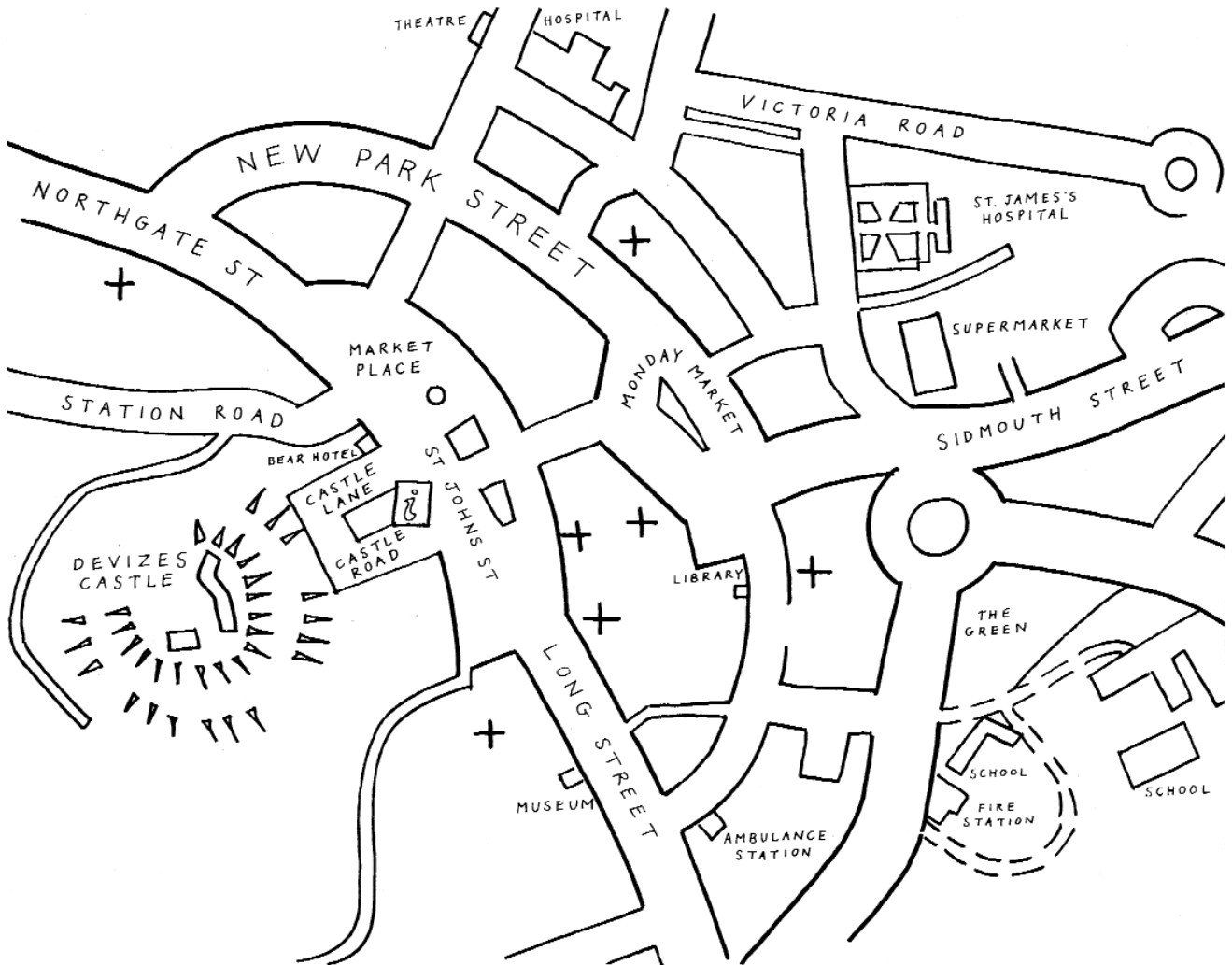


A medieval town
