Subject: Control pressures - IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ

Colleagues

With immediate effect, new measures can be taken which will enable us to ease some of the pressures on the control.

On HMI authority {or CIO authority outside HMI operational hours} you can:

- 1. stop opening chips on EU passports
- 2. stop swiping children's passports on ÉU if they are in a school group or clearly travelling with their family
- 3) stop routinely asking questions of visa holders. In other words, once you have established the passenger is the rightful holder a genuine document which contains a visa which confers leave to enter you should allow them to proceed, subject of course to a WI check.

In all instances, however, if you feel there is a specific risk you may continue to perform these discontinued checks at discretion.

Please note that we are no longer able to suspend Secure ID, except in the most exceptional circumstances. The Home Secretary has not given us that flexibility. Suspension of Secure ID must therefore stop now.

Regarding ACS – it has been made very clear to HMIs that we must maximise usage of ACS. ACS must therefore be kept open at all times when it is technically available.
