Directors' Report – C4 Paper 787 (44/07)

Chief Executive
Overall Industry

The Chief Executive reported that across the industry most of the recent attention has been focussed on the BBC (with the "Queensgate" report and cost cuts announcement) and on ITV (with the announcement of the Deloitte report into

ITV's premium phone activity).

In response to a query by Andy Mollett, the Group Finance Director updated the Board around the timings of the Ofcom investigations into Richard & Judy and

Deal or No Deal.

Performance The Chief Executive reported on the Channel's share and likely market position

for 2008.

25th Anniversary The Chief Executive said that the Channel's 25th Anniversary on 2nd November

was approaching fast. He summarised the events that were being held around the

anniversary.

2008 The Chief Executive noted that a great deal of work and planning was under-way

for 2008 in terms of programming, budgeting and new business.

<u>Director of Television</u> Performance

The Director of Television reported on the Channel 4 audience share and programming. Recent highlights included Millionaires' Mission, Bringing Up Baby and Ghosts.
